- 1. What invention, from the year of your birth to today, do you think has had the most positive impact on our world and why?
- 2. Veeco's vision is "To ENABLE a future where technology improves the HUMAN experience." How do you hope to "Make A *Material* Difference™" in the high-tech world through your STEM education?
