REQUIREMENTS

- U.S. citizen

- Minimum 3.2 GPA on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent based on the scale utilized by the student’s academic institution)
- Majors:
 - Computer Science
 - Electrical Engineering
 - Materials Science
 - Mechanical Engineering
 - Physics
 - Software Engineering
- Final round applicants:
 - Interview with Veeco
 - Formal headshot to be used in scholarship promotions. (The image does not need to be professionally taken.)

ESSAY QUESTION

The applicant must select one of the following questions and submit a 750-1000 words essay response:

1. What invention, from the year of your birth to today, do you think has had the most positive impact on our world and why?
2. Veeco’s vision is “To ENABLE a future where technology improves the HUMAN experience.” How do you hope to “Make A *Material* Difference™” in the high-tech world through your STEM education?
